The Al-Qassam Brigades, the military wing of Hamas, released video footage today of a precise ambush its fighters carried out in Beit Hanoun, northern Gaza, which resulted in the killing of five Israeli soldiers and injuries to approximately 20 more.

Meanwhile, a volunteer doctor at Nasser Medical Complex told Al-Jazeera that the situation in the hospital is extremely catastrophic, with a severe lack of the most basic medical supplies.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 62,819 and injured 158,629 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.
