Since the resumption of the war on Gaza in March, at least 38 Israeli soldiers have been killed and 98 injured in ambushes and sniper attacks.

Since the start of 2025, the total stands at 50 killed and 118 wounded.

Our fighters observed helicopter landings to evacuate the soldiers after the raid.

Our fighters attempted to capture one of the soldiers, but due to battlefield conditions, they killed him and seized his weapon.

Gaza Hospitals Director Warns of Imminent Mass Casualties as Fuel Dries Up in Northern Gaza

ARABIC MEDIA: Marwan Al-Hams, Director of Field Hospitals for Gaza's Ministry of Health, has issued a dire warning, stating that hundreds of people will die due to the depletion of fuel in northern Gaza's hospitals.

Speaking to Al Jazeera, Al-Hams described the situation as "very difficult," with worsening conditions for the wounded amid the spread of epidemics. He specifically mentioned the spread of spinal meningitis, which they are currently unable to manage.

Al-Hams emphasized the immediate threat, stating that the failure to bring in fuel will lead to the death of dozens of premature babies within two days. He added that patients requiring kidney dialysis and intensive care face certain death due to the lack of fuel.

Al-Quds Brigades Targets Israeli Gatherings in Khan Yunis with Mortar Shells

STATEMENT: Al-Quds Brigades, the military wing of the Islamic Jihad movement, has released footage showing its fighters, in cooperation with other Palestinian resistance factions, targeting gatherings of Israeli soldiers and vehicles with mortar shells. The attacks occurred in areas of Israeli incursion within Khan Yunis city, southern Gaza Strip.

Euro-Med Monitor: Israel Planning Forced Detention Camp for Gazans in Rafah

The Euro-Mediterranean Human Rights Monitor has issued a grave warning, stating that Israel is planning to forcibly detain Gaza Strip residents in a closed detention camp built on the ruins of Rafah.

The Monitor highlights that the plan, revealed by Israeli Defense Minister Israel Katz, to relocate Gazan residents to a "humanitarian zone" represents a dangerous escalation in the ongoing genocide.

Key concerns raised by the Euro-Med Monitor include:

Forced Relocation and Restrictions: The plan reportedly involves transferring 600,000 Palestinians after subjecting them to "security checks," with severe restrictions on their movement and prevention from leaving the designated area.

Demographic Change: This plan is seen as a deliberate step to empty Gaza of its inhabitants and forcibly impose a new demographic reality.

"Voluntary Migration" Concern: The danger of this scheme is amplified by the Defense Minister's welcoming of what he called the "voluntary migration" of Palestinians, which the Monitor interprets as Israel adopting a policy of external displacement.

Not Humanitarian, but Ethnic Cleansing: The Monitor asserts that concentrating Gaza's population in the south is not a humanitarian objective, but rather a transitional phase within a systematic plan to depopulate Gaza, representing a direct continuation of displacement and ethnic cleansing policies.

Violation of International Law: The plan is considered a serious violation of international humanitarian law, falling under acts of forced displacement, persecution, and apartheid.

Truce Exploitation: Statements by Katz regarding the exploitation of a temporary ceasefire suggest that the purpose of a truce is not to halt the genocide but to give the army time and field conditions to establish mass detention camps.

Semantic Manipulation: The use of terms like "humanitarian zone" or "humanitarian transit zone" for these camps is seen as intentional manipulation of terminology to justify coercive policies aimed at reshaping Gaza's demographic reality.

Non-Voluntary Departure: Any departure from the Gaza Strip under current circumstances cannot be considered "voluntary," given that residents are stripped of any real ability to make a free decision.

UN Human Rights Spokesperson Urges Immediate Fuel and Aid Entry to Gaza

ARABIC MEDIA: Thamir Al-Khitan, Spokesperson for the UN High Commissioner for Human Rights, told Al Jazeera that fuel and humanitarian aid must be immediately allowed into the Gaza Strip.

Al-Khitan stated that Israel is permitting only a small amount of UN aid to enter Gaza. He added, "We have all witnessed the shooting and aerial bombardment targeting civilians near aid distribution points."

He concluded by calling on influential countries to pressure Israel to allow aid to enter.
