Over 100 Palestinians have been killed and many more wounded by Israeli fire in Gaza since dawn on Tuesday, as the humanitarian catastrophe continues to deepen.

Meanwhile, US President Donald Trump announced that he will hold talks with Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu next Monday.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 57,012 and injured 134,592 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

US Contractors Used Live Ammunition at Gaza Aid Sites

ASSOCIATED PRESS: American private contractors guarding Gaza aid distribution sites have used live ammunition, according to AP sources. Gunfire was reportedly directed indiscriminately, sometimes toward Palestinians waiting for aid. Security staff allegedly used stun grenades and pepper spray routinely. Aid distribution was described as chaotic and lacking leadership.

Home Secretary Yvette Cooper called the protest "shameful" and a threat to national security. The ban comes as several MPs in the same Parliament push for official recognition of a Palestinian state, underscoring a growing divide over UK policy on Palestine.

Meanwhile, in a voice of support for Palestinian rights within the same Parliament, Chair of the Foreign Affairs Committee Milly Thornberry urged the UK to recognize the state of Palestine in coordination with France—highlighting the growing divide in British policy on the issue.
