The Gaza Health Ministry stated that the Strip is in a race against time to confront famine, and the humanitarian response must be wide-ranging.

Meanwhile, four people were killed and scores wounded when Israeli forces bombed the Yemeni capital, Sanaa.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 62,744 and injured 158,259 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

Netanyahu Considers Plan To Bypass Zamir After His Call For A Deal

ISRAELI MEDIA: Israel's Channel 13 reported that Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu's office is considering a proposal to bypass Chief of Staff Eyal Zamir after his call to move forward with a deal in Gaza. One possibility under discussion is appointing an authority above the Chief of Staff to act as supreme commander of the army.

Assessments indicate that Zamir is seen as not aggressive enough and unwilling to occupy Gaza City.

Zamir, however, would not accept the appointment of a commander above him. Netanyahu's office is reportedly angered after Zamir demanded reaching a deal now.

Israeli Media: Nasser Hospital Bombed by Tank

ISRAELI MEDIA: According to sources, Nasser Hospital in Khan Yunis was shelled by an Israeli tank as part of a special forces operation in the area. The investigation is focusing on the chain of approvals granted to the tank before it fired. Firing at a hospital requires authorization from senior command and sometimes from the Chief of Staff. The tank crew carried out orders, but an investigation is necessary into why the order was given to bomb a hospital.

Poll: 73% Of Israelis Support Ending The War

WALLA (quoting a poll by Agam Institute): 73% of Israelis support ending the war and reaching a prisoner exchange deal. Two-thirds of Israelis believe the war is being managed for political reasons. Sixty-four percent of soldiers think the war is directed according to political calculations.

Motivation to serve has dropped among 40% of regular and reserve soldiers. Fifty-four percent of Likud voters support ending the war in Gaza within the framework of a prisoner exchange deal. Seventy-three percent of reserve and regular soldiers are in favor of ending the war, while 26.1% support its continuation.
