The Israeli newspaper Haaretz reported that the Israeli army has killed approximately 1,000 Palestinian children in the Gaza Strip over the past month.

Meanwhile, Ansarallah's military spokesperson, Yahya Saree, said that the group is considering further escalatory options to stop Israel's war and starvation campaign in Gaza.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 59,700 and injured 144,000 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

Georges Abdallah Released After 41 Years in French Prison, Heads to Beirut

AFP: Georges Abdallah, a former member of the Lebanese Armed Revolutionary Factions, was released today, Friday, from a prison in France after approximately 41 years of incarceration. He is now en route to Beirut, following a decision by the Paris Court of Appeal last week to grant his release.

Abdallah was transported in a convoy of six vehicles, including two minibusses, from Lannemezan prison in the Hautes-Pyrénées department of southwestern France to Tarbes airport. From there, he will take a flight to Roissy Airport in Paris before boarding a morning flight bound for Beirut. His lawyer, Jean-Louis Chalanset, told Agence France-Presse after the convoy departed, "This is a source of joy, emotional shock, and political victory all at once after all this time." He emphasized, "He should have been released a very long time ago."

ARABIC MEDIA: The spokesperson for Al-Aqsa Martyrs Hospital told Al-Jazeera that the remaining hospitals in the Gaza Strip are threatened with closure due to critical fuel shortages. This dire situation is exacerbating an already catastrophic humanitarian crisis.

According to the spokesperson:

Children in Gaza are suffering from hunger amid harsh health conditions.

Patients with chronic diseases face the risk of death due to severe shortages of food and medicine. Medical teams themselves are enduring hunger and malnutrition in what are described as catastrophic circumstances.

There are fears of an increase in reported deaths due to the worsening hunger crisis in Gaza. All residents of the Gaza Strip are at risk of malnutrition.

Doctors Without Borders: Israel Implementing Deliberate Starvation in Gaza

STATEMENT: Doctors Without Borders (MSF) has stated that what is happening in Gaza amounts to deliberate starvation of the people by Israeli authorities.

In a statement, MSF clarified that the number of individuals registered for malnutrition treatment at their clinic in Gaza has quadrupled since May 18th.

The organization called on Israeli authorities to permit the widespread entry of food supplies and aid into Gaza, adding that patients and healthcare workers in Gaza are now struggling to survive.
