The Qassam Brigades, the military wing of the Palestinian resistance movement Hamas, announced on Wednesday that 25 Israeli soldiers had been killed or wounded in a series of targeted operations east of Rafah, in the southern Gaza Strip.

Meanwhile, more than 100 international aid organizations and human rights groups have sounded the alarm on the catastrophic famine in Gaza where aid workers are now joining starving civilians in the same food lines, risking being shot by Israeli forces just to feed their families.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 59,106 and injured 142,511 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

The statement highlights that independent journalists have served for months as the eyes and ears of the world in Gaza. The agencies are facing significant challenges in treating sick and hungry journalists and are currently unable to provide them with adequate care.

They are urging Israeli authorities to permit journalists to enter and exit Gaza freely.
