At least six Israeli soldiers were killed and ten others wounded—some critically—during a major resistance operation in Beit Hanoun, northern Gaza.

Israeli news websites reported that Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu was briefed on the details of the "security incident" in Gaza while he was at the White House.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 57,523 and injured 136,617 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

In a preliminary investigation, the Israeli army stated:

- · The Beit Hanoun attack occurred during the movement of two battalions to clear the area.
- A force from Netzah Yehuda Battalion 97 was crossing the road on foot when landmines exploded.
- · Additional rescue teams were dispatched to evacuate the wounded.
- The evacuation was complicated by injuries sustained by the support unit.
- The attack involved the remote detonation of two landmines in a pre-set ambush.
- Five soldiers were killed and 14 injured—two seriously and six moderately.

The incident occurred late Monday when resistance fighters detonated an explosive device under an armored vehicle carrying soldiers, then targeted an ammunition-laden robot with an anti-tank shell during its preparation phase in Beit Hanoun.
