

Either way, the ruling did not seem to alter anything on the ground, as Israel's ongoing war on the Palestinian people continued unabated as well as the continued American support of Israel.

Meanwhile, Palestinian and Arab Resistance, however, escalated their attacks on the Israeli army on several fronts.

According to Gaza's Ministry of Health, 26,257 Palestinians have been killed, and 64,797 wounded in Israel's ongoing genocide in Gaza starting on October 7. Palestinian and international estimates say that the majority of those killed and wounded are women and children.

**Sunday, January 28, 00:50 am (GMT+2)** 

JEREMY CORBYN: Britain joining other countries in suspending funding for UNRWA amounts to collective punishment.

SCOTLAND: We have no plans to provide further support to UNRWA at this stage.

US CENTRAL COMMAND: The Houthis yesterday struck a ship carrying the flag of the Marshall Islands with a ballistic missile.

UNRWA COMMISSIONER-GENERAL: The suspension of the agency's funding is shocking and threatens humanitarian work in the region, especially in Gaza. I call on countries that suspended funding to reconsider their decisions.

FORMER UNRWA SPOKESMAN: Britain's suspension of aid to the agency is completely disproportionate and punitive.

IRISH FM: We have no intention of suspending funding for UNRWA's vital work in Gaza.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Four Palestinians were killed and others wounded in an Israeli bombing that targeted the Malalha area, west of Khan Yunis, in the southern Gaza Strip.

FORMER ISRAELI PM OLMERT: The Israeli government must stop the war immediately and return the kidnapped people.

FINANCIAL TIMES: A British 5-point plan to end the war between Hamas and Israel.

Saturday, January 27, 4:50 pm (GMT+2)

UN OFFICIAL (to Al-Jazeera): 2.2 million people are at risk of famine in Gaza.

ISRAELI ARMY: The Israeli occupation army blew up facilities in the Al-Batn Al-Samin area in Khan Yunis.

AL-JAZEERA: the Israeli army targeted the town of Aita al-Shaab in southern Lebanon with two raids.

GERMAN FM: Israel must immediately allow aid to enter Gaza.

AL-JAZEERA: Britain and Finland announced the suspension of future funding for UNRWA.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: The Israeli army announced the opening of a safe corridor west of Khan Yunis, for the displaced Palestinians to leave for the Al-Mawasi area.

AL-JAZEERA: The center of the city of Khan Yunis is witnessing violent clashes, coinciding with Israeli bombing targeting the area south of the Gaza Strip.

#### Saturday, January 27, 2:55 pm (GMT+2)

AL-QUDS BRIGADES: We bombed a supply line and the movement of Israeli army vehicles east of the Maghazi camp in the central Gaza Strip, with a missile and mortar shell.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: violent clashes are taking place between the Palestinian resistance and the Israeli occupation forces northwest of Gaza City.

PALESTINIAN RED CRESCENT: A displaced Palestinian was killed by Israeli occupation forces fire in the courtyard of Al Amal Hospital in Khan Yunis, south of the Gaza Strip.

AL-JAZEERA: Three Palestinians were martyred in an Israeli bombing targeting citizens near the Kuwait Roundabout in Gaza City.

AL-QUDS BRIGADES: We targeted an Israeli Merkava tank and a troop carrier with RPG shells, west of the city of Khan Yunis, south of the Gaza Strip.

#### Saturday, January 27, 1:00 pm (GMT+2)

AL-JAZEERA: Two Palestinians were killed in an Israeli bombing that targeted the town of Bani Suhaila, east of Khan Yunis, south of the Gaza Strip.

NORWEGIAN FM: Norway continues to support the Palestinian people through UNRWA.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: A crew from the Palestinian Telecommunications Company in Gaza was injured while trying to maintain the network, despite prior coordination.

GAZA HEALTH MINISTRY: 26,257 Palestinians have been killed, and 64,797 wounded in Israel's ongoing genocide in Gaza starting on October 7.

#### Saturday, January 27, 11:40 am (GMT+2)

AL-JAZEERA: 28 bodies and a number of injured people arrived at Nasser Hospital in Khan Yunis, south of the Gaza Strip, as a result of the ongoing Israeli bombing.

NORWEGIAN REFUGEE COUNCIL: The war on Gaza is not a conflict between two equal parties.

AL-QUDS BRIGADES: We are engaged in fierce clashes with the Israeli occupation forces with machine guns and missiles, west and south of Khan Yunis in the southern Gaza Strip.

ISRAELI CHANNEL 12: A rocket shell landed in an open area near the city of Sderot.

HEZBOLLAH: We targeted a deployment of Israeli soldiers in the vicinity of the Jal al-Alam site with Burkan missiles and achieved "direct hits."

ISRAELI FM: Israel welcomes Washington's decision to suspend funding for UNRWA.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: 5 Palestinians were injured in an Israeli artillery shelling near the industrial headquarters in Khan Yunis.

#### Saturday, January 27, 10:00 am (GMT+2)

HAMAS: Hamas strongly condemned Israel's incitement against international institutions that contribute to relief for the Palestinian people, including the World Health Organization and the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Refugees (UNRWA).

AL-JAZEERA: Efforts to control a fire in an oil tanker in the Gulf of Aden continue.

ISRAELI MEDIA: A rocket landed in Western Galilee, causing no casualties.

AL-QASSAM BRIGADES: We targeted an Israeli troop carrier with an Al-Yassin 105 shell in the Al-Amal neighborhood, west of Khan Yunis, in the southern Gaza Strip.

#### Saturday, January 27, 09:00 am (GMT+2)

AL-JAZEERA: Sirens sounded in the town of Shlomi in the Western Galilee, near the border with Lebanon.

#### **Saturday, January 27, 017:00 am (GMT+2)**

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Three Palestinians were killed in an Israeli raid on a house in the El Geneina neighborhood in Rafah, south of the Gaza Strip.

MASIRAH TV: American and British raids targeted the Ras Issa area in Hodeidah Governorate, western Yemen.

US MILITARY OFFICIAL (to ABC): Washington does not want escalation in the region.

Saturday, January 27, 06:00 am (GMT+2)

AL-JAZEERA: More than 10 Palestinians were killed in a bombing by Israeli occupation aircraft that targeted a house for the Fayyad family, southwest of the city of Deir al-Balah in the Gaza Strip.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: 28 Palestinians were killed by continuous Israeli bombing on Khan Yunis within 24 hours.

US CENTRAL COMMAND: We destroyed an anti-ship missile that the Houthis were preparing to launch in the Red Sea at dawn today.

Saturday, January 27, 05:00 am (GMT+2)

AGENCE FRANCE-PRESSE: The UN Security Council will hold an emergency meeting on Wednesday after the International Court of Justice's decision on Gaza.

Saturday, January 27, 03:00 am (GMT+2)

DIPLOMATIC SOURCES (to Al-Jazeera): Algeria called for a Security Council session to discuss the situation in Gaza.

HEZBOLLAH: We targeted a building in Avivim on the Lebanese border and achieved a direct hit.

Saturday, January 27, 02:00 am (GMT+2)

PENTAGON: A Pentagon official confirms that American bases in Iraq and Syria were attacked.

Saturday, January 27, 01:00 am (GMT+2)

HEZBOLLAH: We targeted Israeli occupation soldiers near Metulla with missile weapons, causing direct casualties.

UKMTO: A commercial ship was hit by a missile southeast of Aden and is still on fire.

ISLAMIC RESISTANCE IN IRAQ: targeted, with drones, the American bases of Conico and Green Village in Syria.

HEZBOLLAH: Three of our fighters were killed in southern Lebanon.

The death toll has increased as Israel continues to attack hospitals and intensifies its strikes in the southern Gaza Strip.

Israeli envoy to the United Nations Gilad Erdan attacked United Nations Secretary-General Antonio Guterres after he criticized countries that suspended funding for UNRWA.

According to the New York Times, an agreement between the Israeli government and the Palestinian Resistance movement Hamas is imminent.

According to Gaza's Ministry of Health, 26,422 Palestinians have been killed, and 65,087 wounded in Israel's ongoing genocide in Gaza starting on October 7. Palestinian and international estimates say that the majority of those killed and wounded are women and children.

### LATEST UPDATES

**Sunday, January 28, 10:00 pm (GMT+2)** 

POLITICO: Options for responding to the attack that led to the death of 3 American soldiers and the injury of dozens of others in Jordan are now being developed.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Violent clashes are now taking place between the Palestinian resistance and the occupation forces in the Al-Zaytoun neighborhood, east of Gaza City.

MUJAHIDEEN BRIGADES: We bombed the Israeli Ra'im base, which was the headquarters of the Israeli command of the Gaza Division, with missiles.

HEZBOLLAH: targeted the Israeli Khirbet Maar base with two "Falaq 1" missiles and achieved a direct hit there.

**Sunday, January 28, 10:00 pm (GMT+2)** 

US SECRETARY OF DEFENSE: We will not tolerate attacks on American forces.

JORDAN: We condemn the terrorist attack that targeted an advanced site on the border with Syria.

AL-JAZEERA: Continuous Israeli raids on homes and apartments in Gaza City and the Nuseirat camp in the central Gaza Strip have so far left 40 Palestinians killed and dozens injured.

AL-QUDS BRIGADES: We bombed the settlements surrounding the Gaza Strip with concentrated missile bursts.

AL-JAZEERA: 12 Israeli ministers, some of them from the Likud Party led by Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu, and more than 15 Knesset members participated in a conference on

returning settlements to Gaza, amid calls by participants from far-right supporters to "displace" Palestinians from the Gaza Strip.

#### Sunday, January 28, 9:00 pm (GMT+2)

TOP HAMAS OFFICIAL: The head of Hamas abroad, Sami Abu Zuhri, said that they warned the American administration of the expansion of the conflict in the Middle East as a result of the aggression on Gaza.

ISLAMIC RESISTANCE IN IRAQ: In 100 days, we carried out 178 attacks with drones and missiles on American and Israeli sites in Iraq, Syria and the occupied territories.

AL-QASSAM BRIGADES: We destroyed 11 Israeli military vehicles within 48 hours.

WASHINGTON POST: The Pentagon is investigating the failure of the air defense at the "Tower 22" base.

AL-AQSA TV: Israeli occupation aircraft are now throwing fire belts and violent raids on the western and northern neighborhoods of Gaza City.

#### **Sunday, January 28, 8:00 pm (GMT+2)**

KAMALA HARRIS: The attack on our forces in northeastern Jordan was carried out by armed groups supported by Iran.

PALESTINIAN RED CRESCENT: Israeli military vehicles surround Al-Amal Hospital in Khan Yunis.

WALL STREET JOURNAL (quoting US official): Iraqi militias attacked with a drone Tower 22, a small military site in Jordan near the Syrian border.

#### Sunday, January 28, 7:00 pm (GMT+2)

JORDAN: Minister of Government Communications and spokesman for the Jordanian government, Muhannad Moubaideen, said that the attack that targeted American soldiers did not occur on Jordanian soil.

CNN: Three US soldiers were killed and 24 wounded in an attack in Jordan near the Syrian border.

#### **Sunday, January 28, 6:30 pm (GMT+2)**

GALLANT: We will not stop as long as we have detainees in Gaza.

GAZA GOVERNMENT MEDIA OFFICE: The Israeli army committed 38 massacres that claimed the lives of 350 martyrs during the past 48 hours.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: The bodies of 35 martyrs were buried in a mass grave inside the Nasser Medical Complex in Khan Yunis, south of the Gaza Strip.

AL-JAZEERA: Several Palestinians were killed and wounded in an Israeli bombing that targeted a residential apartment east of the Nuseirat camp in the central Gaza Strip.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: 24 Palestinians were killed in the Israeli bombing on Khan Yunis during the last 24 hours.

EURO-MED MONITOR: Israel is besieging the hospitals that remained partially operational in Khan Yunis.

#### Sunday, January 28, 5:30 pm (GMT+2)

WHITE HOUSE: There is no change in our policy towards Israel.

AL-JAZEERA: Sirens sound in Katsarin, south of the Golan Heights, on suspicion of infiltration from Lebanon.

AL-QUDS BRIGADES: We are engaged in fierce clashes with Israeli soldiers, in the areas of Al-Amal, Al-Maskar and Abasan Al-Kabira neighborhoods in Khan Yunis, south of the Gaza Strip.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Israeli raids targeted Jabal Balat and the surroundings of the towns of Marwahin and Aita al-Shaab in southern Lebanon.

HEZBOLLAH: We targeted Israeli soldiers with missiles at the Tal Shaar site and achieved direct hits.

AL-JAZEERA: missiles were launched towards Israeli positions in the Upper Galilee, off the eastern sector of southern Lebanon.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Clashes with machine guns occurred in Jabalia, north of the Gaza Strip.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: An Israeli bombing targeted the southern areas of Gaza City.

NBC: The Biden administration is discussing stopping arms shipments to Israel.

AL-JAZEERA: The Knesset General Assembly will vote tomorrow, Monday, on a proposal of no confidence in the government presented by Israeli opposition leader Yair Lapid.

Sunday, January 28, 4:30 pm (GMT+2)

TURKISH FM: We are concerned about some countries suspending their funding to UNRWA.

**Sunday, January 28, 3:30 pm (GMT+2)** 

FRENCH FM: The French Foreign Ministry said that it has suspended aid directed to the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees (UNRWA) for the first quarter of 2024.

AL-QUDS BRIGADES: We targeted 3 Israeli military vehicles with RPG shells in the Al-Amal neighborhood and Jourat Al-Aqqad, west of Khan Yunis.

AL-JAZEERA: A Palestinian was martyred and others injured, as a result of an Israeli artillery shelling that targeted a school housing displaced people in the Al Amal neighborhood, west of Khan Yunis.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Israeli artillery shelling renewed on the northern areas of the Gaza Strip.

HEZBOLLAH: We targeted Israeli enemy soldiers in and around the Ramim barracks with missiles, causing direct hits.

AL-JAZEERA: Sirens sounded in Sderot, Efim and Niram in the Gaza Strip.

CHANNEL 12: The Israeli army declared the Kerem Shalom crossing a closed military zone.

UNRWA: Suspension of funding will stop our activities in Gaza within weeks.

AL-JAZEERA: Palestinian citizens were injured while waiting for aid to enter, after the Israeli army targeted the Kuwait Roundabout in Gaza City.

SAUDI FM: Israel is practicing a systematic starvation policy.

**Sunday, January 28, 2:00 pm (GMT+2)** 

EGYPTIAN FM: The situation in the Red Sea is a direct result of what is happening in Gaza.

ISLAMIC RESISTANCE IN IRAQ: We targeted the American Harir base near Erbil Airport with a drone.

BRITISH DEFENSE MINISTER: Houthi attacks cannot be tolerated.

UNRWA: The rainy weather exacerbated the suffering of hundreds of thousands of displaced people in Gaza.

HEZBOLLAH: We targeted Israeli soldiers with missiles east of the Birkat Risha site in southern Lebanon, causing direct hits.

JORDANIAN FM: UNRWA should not be punished based on accusations against 12 people.

ISRAELI ARMY: 2,765 soldiers have been injured since the beginning of the war.

BEN-GVIR: Israeli Minister of National Security Itamar Ben Gvir said that he decided to extend the weapons licenses that were distributed to the Israelis since the beginning of the war on Gaza for a period of 6 months.

ISRAELI ARMY: Eight soldiers were injured in the Gaza battles in the past 24 hours.

IRANIAN FM: The war in Gaza is not the solution.

CHANNEL 12: Israeli Channel 12 published a video clip of the removal of the South African flag from the center of the city of Rishon LeZion, near Tel Aviv, in implementation of the orders of the city's mayor following the lawsuit filed by Pretoria at the International Court of Justice in The Hague against Israel, accusing it of genocide in the Gaza Strip.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Heavy flight of Israeli warplanes north of the Gaza Strip.

AL-JAZEERA: Israeli aircraft launched two raids on the towns of Zabqin and Hula in southern Lebanon, without immediate reports of deaths or injuries.

MAARIV: The return of Hamas activity previously controlled by the Israeli army in the northern Gaza Strip raises concern in Tel Aviv.
