Top Hamas official Osama Hamdan said the group has presented a comprehensive plan for a full agreement, including a halt to the aggression on the Gaza Strip, the opening of crossings, and the launch of reconstruction efforts.

Meanwhile, Israeli forces continued to carry out massacres across Gaza, as the US approved a \$510 million munitions deal with Israel.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 56,647 and injured 134,105 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.
