Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 56,412 and injured 133,054 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

In contrast, 34% of Israelis prefer to continue fighting in Gaza, believing that military pressure will lead to the return of the captives.

The survey also reveals differing opinions on the motivations behind the war's continuation:

48% of Israelis believe that the continuation of the war in Gaza is driven by political reasons.

37% of Israelis consider the continuation of the war in Gaza to be for security considerations.
