Over 100 Palestinians have been killed and many more wounded by Israeli fire in Gaza since dawn on Wednesday, as the humanitarian catastrophe continues to deepen.

Meanwhile, Palestinian Resistance groups, led by the Al-Quds Brigades, announced a series of complex and coordinated attacks against Israeli occupation forces.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 57,130 and injured 135,173 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

The office added that these massacres primarily involved the targeting of families, shelters, markets, and vital facilities.

Report: Fatah-Affiliated Armed Groups Operating Against Hamas in Gaza with Israeli Coordination

ISRAELI MEDIA: An Israeli newspaper, Yedioth Ahronoth, has reported the presence of armed groups affiliated with Fatah operating against Hamas in the northern and southern Gaza Strip, in addition to the "Abu Shabab" groups active in Rafah.

According to the report:

These groups are led by Yasser Huneideq and Rami Helles, both Fatah cadres who receive salaries from the Palestinian Authority.

The groups led by Yasser Huneideq and Rami Helles are working against Hamas in Gaza in coordination with the Israeli army.

Helles and his group are reportedly fighting Hamas in the Shuja'iya area, while Huneideq and his group are active in the Khan Yunis area. Both groups led by Yasser Huneideq and Rami Helles are said to be receiving weapons and humanitarian aid from Israel.

The Guardian: Israel Used 500-Pound Bomb in Gaza Beach Cafe Attack

UK MEDIA: The Guardian newspaper reports that the Israeli military used a 500-pound bomb in its attack on a beachfront cafe in Gaza last Monday.

According to the investigation, the bomb is considered an indiscriminate weapon, capable of creating a massive blast wave and scattering shrapnel over a wide area.

Legal experts cited by the newspaper stated that the large crater left by the explosion indicates the use of a powerful bomb like the "MK-82." They added that using such munitions is likely illegal and could constitute a war crime.

The Guardian also reported that the Israeli military stated the cafe attack is currently under review, and that steps were taken before the strike to minimize the risk of civilian harm.

85% of Gaza Under Displacement Orders or Military Zones, Warns UN OCHA

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: The UN Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs (OCHA) has stated that approximately 85% of Gaza's territory is currently subject to displacement orders or falls within military zones.

OCHA reported that Khan Yunis's main water distribution center is now inaccessible due to a displacement order, warning that any damage to its reservoir could lead to a collapse of the city's primary water distribution system.

The office emphasized that displacement orders continue to exert significant pressure on vital services in Gaza and are increasingly forcing people into smaller and smaller areas of the Strip.
