A video published on the Al-Qassam Telegram channel under the title "Urgent Warning" featured a QR code and included images of 45 Israeli prisoners, one of whom was shown covering his face in grief.

Meanwhile, the Wall Street Journal reported that Israeli ministers and security officials are privately urging Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu to reach a ceasefire deal as Israeli Reserve Major General Yitzhak Brik has warned that Netanyahu's plan to reoccupy Gaza City could lead to a 'Vietnam scenario'.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 64,300 and injured 162,005 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

Speaking to journalists via video from the Gaza Strip, UNICEF spokesperson Tess Ingram said that the youngest and most vulnerable residents of Gaza City are struggling to survive due to the collapse of basic services. She emphasized that everything possible must be done to prevent an imminent, large-scale Israeli military offensive to avoid an unimaginable tragedy.

The UNICEF spokesperson added that malnutrition and famine are weakening children's bodies, while displacement deprives them of shelter and care, and shelling threatens their every movement.

Khan Yunis's Al-Mawasi Area Becomes a Hub of Thirst and Overcrowding

OXFAM AMERICA: The Al-Mawasi area of Khan Yunis has become a hotspot for thirst and overcrowding, amid warnings about the consequences of displaced Palestinians from the northern Gaza Strip moving there.

According to James Heubler, a humanitarian policy advisor at Oxfam America, Israel is issuing conflicting evacuation orders to people. He noted that Gazans have faced evacuation orders repeatedly during the current war, with many being displaced more than 10 times to locations that lack healthcare and essential services due to extensive damage.

Woman killed in Al-Rimal neighborhood:

Gaza ambulance and emergency services report that a woman was killed in an Israeli bombing of a building housing displaced people in the Al-Rimal neighborhood, central Gaza City.

4 killed in helicopter strike:

Four Palestinians were killed in a helicopter bombing on a displaced people's tent inside the Islamic University, south of Gaza City, according to Gaza ambulance and emergency services.

1 killed in bombing of residential apartment:

Gaza Strip Ambulance and Emergency Services report one person killed and several others wounded in an Israeli bombing of a residential apartment in the Al-Daraj neighborhood, east of Gaza City.
