Hospital sources in Gaza reported that 73 Palestinians were martyred by Israeli fire since dawn today, including 43 in Gaza City.

Meanwhile, the Qassam Brigades released footage of fighters targeting Israeli tanks and armored vehicles in Jabaliya as part of the newly launched "Moses' Staff" operations, a response to Israel's Gideon 2 campaign.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 64,231 and injured 161,583 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

Dozens Killed as Israel Intensifies Airstrikes in Gaza

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Israeli airstrikes on homes and displaced persons' tents have killed dozens of people in Gaza, with the military also reporting a ballistic missile launch from Yemen.

Strikes and Massacres in Gaza

According to Al-Aqsa TV, dozens of Palestinians, mostly children, have been killed or wounded in a series of consecutive Israeli airstrikes on homes and tents for displaced people in the neighborhoods of Al-Sabra, Sheikh Radwan, Al-Nasr, and Tal Al-Hawa in Gaza City. The network described the situation as "another night of hell."

The Palestinian Information Center reported that Israeli forces detonated an explosive robot among homes in the Sheikh Radwan neighborhood and are firing on residences in the vicinity of Al-Jalaa in northwestern Gaza City.

Yemen Missile Launch

The Israeli military has confirmed it detected the launch of a ballistic missile from Yemen targeting Israel and stated that it is working to intercept it.

Hamas Official: We Agreed to the Mediators' Proposal, But Netanyahu Wants Endless War

STATEMENT: A senior Hamas official stated that the group accepted the mediators' proposal for a comprehensive deal but accused Israeli Prime Minister Netanyahu of stonewalling, claiming he seeks a war without end.

Izzat al-Risheq, a senior leader in Hamas, addressed US President Donald Trump, stating that Hamas had agreed on August 18th to a mediators' proposal originally based on a plan by US envoy Stephen Witkoff.

Al-Risheq said that Hamas is prepared for a comprehensive deal that would see the release of all Israeli prisoners in exchange for an agreed-upon number of Palestinians in Israeli jails. Such a deal would also include a ceasefire and the full withdrawal of Israeli forces from Gaza.

He noted that Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu has not yet responded to the proposal. Al-Risheq accused Netanyahu of being the "real obstacle" to both prisoner exchange deals and a ceasefire, asserting that the Israeli leader's ultimate goal is a war with no end.
