Meanwhile, the Maghreb section of the Global Sumud Flotilla has postponed its departure from Tunisia from Sunday to next Wednesday. It will join other ships sailing from Spain and Italy, all heading to Gaza to attempt to break the siege on the Palestinian population.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 64,368 and injured 162,367 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

#### Hamas: Received US Ideas for Ceasefire Agreement

HAMAS STATEMENT: Hamas said it has received ideas from the US side, conveyed through mediators, for reaching a ceasefire agreement. Hamas welcomed any move that contributes to ending the aggression, and affirmed its readiness to immediately sit at the negotiating table to discuss the release of all captives in exchange for a clear declaration ending the war.

The movement said it is ready to negotiate an agreement that includes the release of prisoners, a full Israeli withdrawal, and the formation of an independent committee to manage Gaza.

Hamas stressed that binding guarantees are required to ensure Israel publicly commits to the agreement, to prevent a repeat of previous experiences. The statement added that Hamas remains in constant contact with mediators to develop the US proposals into a comprehensive deal that meets the demands of the Palestinian people.

## Rights Group: Israel Aims to Destroy Gaza's Communications Infrastructure

STATEMENT: A human rights organization is warning that Israel is deliberately targeting Gaza's communications infrastructure to deepen its policy of urban erasure, isolate civilians, and force them to flee.

The Euro-Mediterranean Human Rights Monitor has issued a warning about an impending cutoff of communication and internet networks in Gaza due to the ongoing Israeli bombardment of residential towers.

According to the group, targeting high-rise buildings in Gaza poses a direct threat to the telecommunications sector because local companies have installed crucial technical equipment on the roofs of these buildings.

The organization stated that Israel is seeking to destroy what remains of the communications and internet infrastructure to impose total isolation on civilians, thereby compelling them to forcibly displace.

The rights group added that cutting off communications also seriously hinders the work of medical and aid teams.
