President Isaac Herzog intervened, calling on soldiers to obey Zamir’s orders. The military will begin issuing 54,000 draft notices in July as part of its plan to expand conscription.

The NGO urged international pressure on Israel to allow fuel entry into Gaza.

Since Israel resumed its assault in March after backing out of a ceasefire deal, nearly 6,800 Palestinians have been killed and almost 24,000 injured.

Qassem also insisted that any future national defense strategy would only be discussed once the first phase of the ceasefire agreement is achieved.

He argued that only complete control, an end to aid, and the encouragement of migration would achieve Israel’s goals.
