Palestinian media reported that ten Palestinians were killed and over 120 others were injured due to artillery shelling and gunfire by Israeli occupation forces targeting civilians waiting for aid on Salah Al-Din Street in central Gaza.

Meanwhile, Newsweek, citing a source within the Ansarallah group, confirmed that the group remains on high alert and is working to escalate its operations against Israel.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 55,207 and injured 127,891 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.
