Israel's Channel 12 reported on Sunday that a confidential internal military document acknowledges the failure of Operation Gideon's Chariots in the Gaza Strip.

Meanwhile, the Qassam Brigades published, for the first time, photos of senior leaders killed since October 7, including Mohammed Deif and Mohammed Sinwar, hours after Israel claimed it targeted spokesman Abu Obeida.

Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 63,459 and injured 160,256 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

Israel is Guilty of Genocide in Gaza, Says World Body of Genocide Scholars
